**TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Expense: Town Manager Rhodes reported 88.56% of the current budget has been expended. The 2008/2009 fiscal year will end under budget.

June 8,2009 Selectmen Minutes

Revenue Sharing: May 14<sup>th</sup> Appropriations Committee Changes: Town Manager Rhodes said the Town of Clinton will have a loss of \$90,000 in revenue sharing in the upcoming fiscal year. If the excise tax questions passes in November, and with other revenue cuts, the Town will be looking at a non-tax revenue loss of approximately \$486,000. Unless the Townspeople vote to increase the tax cap, the Town will see a loss of departments and cuts in services. Approximately 25% of the municipal budget in FY 10 / 11 would be cut.

Town Manager Rhodes provided the Board with a copy of the signed Solid Waste Transfer/Recycling Facility Agreement with the Town of Benton.

**WARRANT:** Selectman Clark moved to approve warrant 75 in the amount of \$209,171.43, second by Selectman Nutting. All in favor.

## RESOLUTION 09-05

### BOARD OF SELECTMEN ANNUAL RE-AFFIRMATION OF THE DESIGNATED MUNICIPAL CAPITAL RESERVE FUNDS (CFR)

WHEREAS, Town Charter Section 5.04 Capital Improvement Program subsection ( c ) specifies: “ The Board of Selectmen shall have the authority to create reserve funds as authorized by laws of the State of Maine or that they deem advisable. The resolution creating such fund shall include a statement as to the intent and purpose of the fund, the funding mechanism, and the authority to use and withdraw from the fund”; and

WHEREAS, state law 30-A §5802 specifies that the Municipal Officers (Board of Selectmen) are trustees of the Municipal Reserve Funds and as the trustees, the Board of Selectmen have the authority to expend funds from the reserve funds for their stated purposes; and

WHEREAS, there are fifteen (15) created designated municipal capital reserve funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF CLINTON, that the Board of Selectmen re-affirm the following designated municipal capital reserve funds and specify the intent and purpose of the funds, the funding mechanism, and the authority to use and withdraw from the fund as follows:

1. Account # 2-734-00 Recycling.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of recycling equipment.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund.

b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, has the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.



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**Balance: \$4,902.22.**

**Town approved \$2,000.00 6/9/09 for recycling bailer.**

**Net balance: \$6,902.22.**

2. Account # 2-735-00 Capital Equipment.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of capital equipment not specified by other reserve funds.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund. b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, has the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.

**Balance: \$1,154.81.**

3. Account 2-735-01 Fire.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of Fire Department vehicles and equipment.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund. b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, has the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.

**Balance: \$30,852.18.**

**Town approved \$15,000 6/9/09 for Ambulance Remount.**

**Net Balance: \$45,852.18**

4. Account 2-735-02 Police.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of Police Department vehicles and equipment.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund. b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget



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account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, have the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.

**Balance:** \$64.52

5. Account 2-735-03 Backhoe.

7. Account 2-735-05 Plow Truck.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of a plow truck for the Highway Department.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund.



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b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, have the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.

**Balance:** \$113.16.

**Town approved \$5,000 6/9/09.**

**Net Balance:** \$5,113.16.

8. Account 2-735-06 Forklift.

**Intent / Purpose:** Funds the purchase of a forklift for the Transfer Station and Recycling Center.

**Funding Mechanism:** a. Annual Town Meeting vote to move funds from the undesignated fund balance to the designated reserve fund. b. Board of Selectmen, by resolution, may use unencumbered budget account balance prior to the close out of the fiscal year to transfer into designated reserve fund. c. Taxes raised and appropriated.

**Authority to use / withdraw funds:** Board of Selectmen, by resolution, have the authority to use / withdraw from the designated reserve fund for its stated purpose.

**Balance:** \$6,734.78.

**Town approved \$2,000.00 6/9/09 for forklift.**

**Net balance = \$8,734.78.**

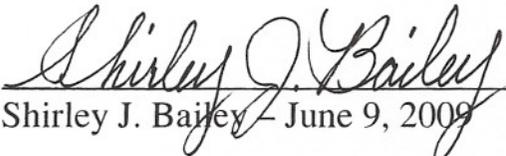
