SPECIAL SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Towne at 6:30 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Chairman Towne led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Also present Town Manager Aaron Chrostowsky, Fire Chief Gary Petley, Transfer Station Director Gerald Howard, Librarian Cheryl Dickey-Whitish, Police Chief Craig Johnson, and Town Clerk Pamela Violette. Vice Chairman David Watson II arrived at 6:50 P.M.

PUBLIC HEARING: Draft 2012 Annual Town Meeting Warrant

Selectman Dixon moved Board open the Public Hearing on the Draft 2012 Annual Town Meeting Warrant and recommended FY 12/13 Municipal Budget at 6:32 P.M., second by Selectman Irving. Vote 4-0

Town Manager Chrostowsky provided a presentation of the State of the Town. Town Manager Chrostowsky reviewed revenues, expenditures, town valuation, accomplishments of the Town in the current year, and a look to the future for the Town of Clinton.

Chairman Towne reviewed Draft 2012 Annual Town Meeting Warrant Articles 1 through 41.

Article 35 – Town Manager Chrostowsky gave a brief presentation of road costs and projects set by the Road Advisory Committee: Johnson Flat Road is the first priority, followed by the Horseback Road, Bush Road, McAllister Road, and Morrison Avenue.

Questions asked by the public were centered on road articles, Browne Memorial Library and Articles 40 and 41 (submitted by petition) for the sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises of a licensed establishment.

Selectman Dixon moved Board close the Public Hearing at 7:40 P.M., second by Selectman Irving. Vote 5-0
