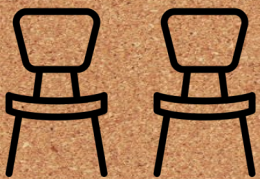
- **40 DAYS** to circulate papers for signatures

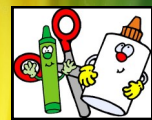

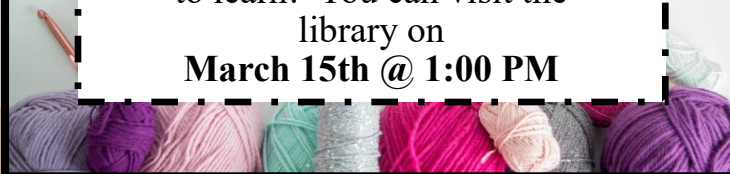

Starter pots and soil will be available

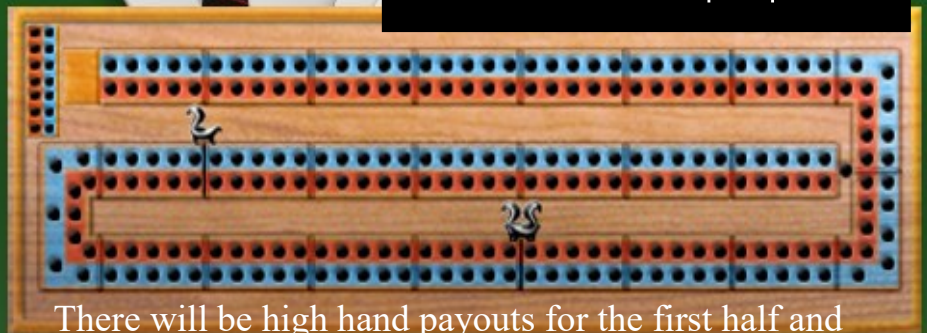


Cribbage Tournament
