BAN ON PARKING ON RAILROAD STREET SIDEWALKS

Recently the Town of Clinton invested over \$33,000 in rehabilitation of 1,400 feet of the Railroad Street sidewalks. Sidewalks that were destroyed by residents not using driveways for parking; library patrons, and heavy hauler delivery and service trucks opting to park on sidewalks built for pedestrian traffic not cars, pick-up trucks and delivery trucks.

Therefore, the Clinton Board of Selectmen has taken the unusual step to enact a Parking Ban on Railroad Street Sidewalks effective immediately. The Clinton Police Department will regularly patrol Railroad Street to ensure this ban is being honored and will issue a "Notice of Violation" to those parking on the sidewalk. The Notice of Violation will be provided to the Board of Selectmen.

This notice of a ban on parking on sidewalks is being sent to all corporate and private entities known to reside or do business on Railroad Street in hopes that out of respect for the town's large sum investment in the sidewalks the practice will be halted immediately. In the event the sidewalks continue to be abused Selectmen will seek remedy by developing an ordinance that will contain fines as a deterring factor. The Selectmen hope that step will not be necessary.

We appreciate your assistance with preserving the value of taxpayer investments and cooperating with the Ban on Parking on Railroad Street Sidewalks.
